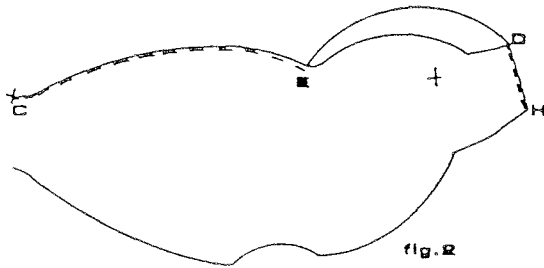

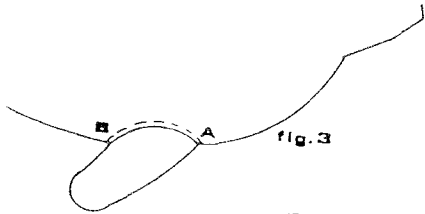

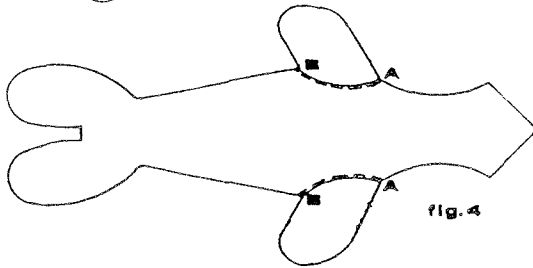

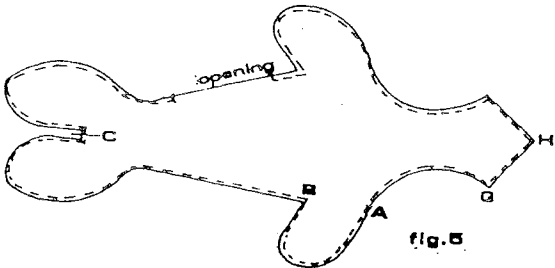

SEAL

105300 "MARK"	white
105321 "MADELENE"	pink
105322 "SPENCER"	blue
105327 "KIKI"	salmon
105330 "Dave"	aqua

Use diagram A to identify the pieces and mark the letters on the back of the fabric.

Sewing: Stitch pieces together with right sides facing.

- * Sew up the dart J-L on piece called Body. Fig. 1
- * Stitch the forehead to both sides of the body, from E to D. Fig. 1
- * Stitch together both body-sides, from D to H and from E to C. Fig. 2
- * Stitch one foreleg to the left and one foreleg to the right body side, from A to B. Fig. 3
- * Stitch the other two forelegs to the body-front, from A to B. Fig. 4
- * Stitch body front to body begin at H and stitch via L and G to A.
- * From here stitch around the foreleg to B then to C; stitch together the other side in the same way; leave an opening for the stuffing. Fig. 5
- * Turn the seal right side out.
- * Attach the nose to point D and the eyes on the designated spots.
- * Stuff the seal and close up the opening by hand.

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
